Important Notes:

- It is the Borough of West Wildwood's policy not to grant a handicapped parking space to those who possess off-street parking unless they can establish a hardship why it cannot be utilized by the disabled person.
- Approval of a handicapped space for those who establish a hardship may be denied when re-application is requested during audit periods due to the hardship no longer existing.
- For those applicants who do not possess adequate space in front of their residence a letter from the home owner where the space will be located authorizing the space to be placed there must be attached to this application.
- The West Wildwood Police Department reserves the right to remove handicapped spaces for any reason and may request re-application at any time.
