
WHEREAS, the FUND requires the MUNICIPALITY to designate specific managerial or supervisory individuals who will have access to the HELPLINE;

WHEREAS, the current one year contact will be expiring on May 4, 2016, and so that there is no interruption in service the Borough is submitting the renewal application at least 45 days before the date of expiration; and



WHEREAS, the high bidder executed an Offer to Purchase said property;




