Reports from Commissioners:

Mayor gave the Police Activity Report for the month of October 2017 total 376 calls. (copy attached). Comm. Golden reported 100 work orders for DPW, copy is available to the public, and reported that the DPW is working on repairing flood gates, it is taking some time since they are waiting on parts. Mayor Fox announced the next regular meeting and tree lighting ceremony on Nov. 30, 2017 at 6:00pm.

Mayor opened the meeting to floor for public comment.

MAUREEN SMITH, 30 Venice Avenue, informed the public that the Ladies Auxiliary will provide hot chocolate, coffee, candy and cookies for the tree lighting; also the Margaret Mace Elementary School Choir will be participating. If anyone would like to make some baked goods to reach out to her or bring them the night of the ceremony. The church will be open the night of the tree lighting for people to walk through. Mayor Fox explained that the church has been through a lot financially due to the past two major storms, and encourages people to walk through.

SUSAN CZWALINA, 547 W. Maple Avenue, asked for clarification regarding the lawsuit and the bond; and questioned the amount, believing that the lawsuit was not as much as the bond amount. Comm. Golden explained why the bond is being put in place and that the borough is waiting for the outcome with the insurance company coverage. Administrator Ridings explained that there was the jury judgement amount, but there are also attorney fees to be considered. The borough anticipates insurance coverage.

JOHN WELSH, 741 W. Poplar Avenue, questioned if there is a time table as to when the insurance issue would be resolved and how the outcome would be communicated to the residents. Comm. Golden stated that the borough doesn't have a time frame. Solicitor Karavan explained that this matter is in litigation, when it has been litigated it will be communicated to the public. Comm. Golden stated the decision would be communicated at a public meeting or on the borough's website. The solicitor explained this matter is in the superior court level; when a decision is reached possible appeals could be filed from both sides; there are tiers as it moves through the court system.

SUSAN CZWALINA, 547 W. Maple Avenue, questioned where on the website this information would be placed. Administrator Ridings, stated in an appropriate location.

ORDINANCE NO. 564 (2017)

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 337 AND ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE ED LUSK MEMORIAL PARK THE GLENWOOD AVENUE PUBLIC BEACH AND THE BAY AVENUE PLAYGROUND

WHEREAS, the Borough of West Wildwood has established the Ed Lusk Memorial Park on the premises known as a portion of Block 103, :Lot 1 on the Tax Map of the Borough of West Wildwood; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of West Wildwood has established the Glenwood Avenue Public Beach situate on the remainder of Block 103, Lot 1, and on Block 102, Lot 1 on the Tax Map of the Borough of West Wildwood; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of West Wildwood has established the Bay Avenue Playground on the premises known as Block 103, Lots 2.08, 2.09 and 2.12, on the Tax Map of the Borough of West Wildwood; and

WHEREAS, it has been deemed necessary and desirable to establish rules and regulations for the utilization of said Park, Beach and Playground;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of West Wildwood, County of Cape May, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section I.

The Rules and Regulations set forth in Schedule "A" annexed hereto be and hereby are established by the Borough of West Wildwood to cover the premises known as the Ed Lusk Memorial Park, the Glenwood Avenue Public Beach and the Bay Avenue Playground, more particularly described as Block 102, Lot 1; Block 103, Lot 1; and Block 103, Lots 2.08, 2.09 and 2.12, on the Tax Map of the Borough of West Wildwood.

Section II Penalty for Violations

Any person or association of persons convicted of a violation of the Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine of not less than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars or more than One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars and/or imprisonment in the County Jail for up to thirty (30) days for each offense. Each day that a violation continues after service of official notice of such violation shall be considered a separate offense subject to separate additional penalties.

Section III. Repealer

All other Ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

Section IV. Survival

Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect, at to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

Section V. Effective Date of Ordinance

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication, according to law.


