The clerk provided the commissioners with draft agenda items. There was a discussion of possible agenda items for the regular meeting. Comm. Golden discussed the matter of a complaint of basketball hoops on the sidewalk curb line. Mayor and Commissioners agreed that at this time there is no need to enact any ordinances on this issue and will act on any complaints filed. Discussion by Comm. Golden regarding a need to hire full time police officers to be properly staffed. Administrator Ridings stated the Chief of Police, provided two candidates for consideration, Nicole Fox and Officer Brandon Turner (who is currently a class II Officer on the WPPD); and Nicole Fox was a Class II Officer for the City of Wildwood. Administrator Ridings informed the Mayor and Commissioners that both candidates have attended the Police Academy and are trained Class II officers. Clerk inquired if resolutions of appointment should be prepared and added to the regular meeting agenda. Comm. Golden confirmed. There was a discussion regarding the bid process and time frame for the construction and completion of the ADA ramp at the beach. There was a discussion regarding the hiring of conflict counsel. There was a discussion regarding the budget introduction, over-all a zero-tax increase.
