**ORDINANCE NO. 596(2021)** 

# AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 564 (2017) AS TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE ED LUSK MEMORIAL PARK, THE GLENWOOD AVENUE PUBLIC BEACH, AND THE BAY AVENUE PLAYGROUND

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Borough Commissioners of the Borough of West Wildwood wish to repeal and replace Ordinance No. 564 (2017) which established in its Schedule "A" the Rules and Regulations for the utilization of the Ed Lusk Memorial Park, the Glenwood Avenue Public Beach, and the Bay Avenue Playground.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED,** by the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of West Wildwood, in the County of Cape May, New Jersey, that Ordinance No. 564 (2017) be and is revised with the following changes to Schedule "A" (additions indicated in boldface and italics *thus*; deletions indicated with strike-through thus):

#### Section 1.

- 1. No dogs shall be permitted on the subject premises at any time between May 1<sup>st</sup> and October 30<sup>th</sup> of each year.
- 2. Leashed dogs shall be permitted on the Glenwood Avenue Beach between November 1st and April 30th of each year.
- 3. No Alcoholic beverages shall be permitted on the subject premises at any time.
- 4. No fires or barbecues shall be permitted on the subject premises at any time.
- 5. No boat launching or moorings shall be permitted on the Glenwood Avenue Public Beach at any time, with the exception of kayaks and paddle boards. *Kayaks and paddle boards may be launched between May 1st and October 30th of each year.*
- 6. The Borough shall not provide lifeguards for the Glenwood Avenue Public Beach. Any persons swimming, kayaking or paddle boarding shall do so at his/her own risk.

## Section 2.

If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section,

paragraph, subsection, clause, or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

### Section 3.

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and filing with the Borough of West Wildwood Planning Board, and as otherwise provided for by law.
